### REPORT TO UPDATE ON ONGOING ACTIVITIES

Douala, 23.01.2021

#### 1. Introduction

The Littoral coordination team was created in July 2020 to provide direction and coordinate initiatives of the Regional Chapter of ONIGE including the proper functioning of the Regional Secretariat, review of new application files and to set up a framework for the implementation of actions arising from the Adhoc Committee in liaison with the Council. Communication on the creation of this leadership team was done in the WhatsApp Message of 29.07.2020.

The team has been holding regular online meetings and has made some significant achievements.

- On Admissions, the team has reviewed five new applications and submitted to Council with observations for each of the applications.
- On the functioning of the secretariat, the team has come up with some funding proposals which is under review.
- On the follow up of actions from the regional adhoc committee the team has made significant progress and will be the substance of what follows.

#### 3. ONIGE Participation in Workshop ENEO-CVUC

In September 2020 ONIGE was invited to participate in the Workshop on Electrical Safety jointly organised by [ENEO Cameroon](#) and the [United Councils and Cities of Cameroon](#), known by its French abbreviation [CVUC](#), within the framework of an existing partnership agreement between the two major organisations. The President Designated some Members of the Littoral Leadership Team to participate in this Workshop.

Amongst the recommendations were the following :

- ONIGE should designate qualified persons to participate in the Commission for issuance of Building Permits
- ONIGE should participate in sensitization of Municipalities on electrical Safety
- Electrical Engineers should provide guidelines on the best Practices in Electrical safety

In order to establish a framework in which ONIGE can respond to the demands of the external stakeholders the Littoral Regional Leadership Team proposed to create two further work groups.

- **The Engineers’ Grading Matrix**

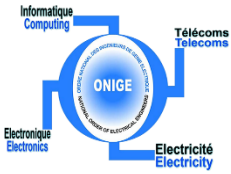
This matrix is presented to Council for examination. The Matrix is meant to be a working document which be improved.

- **Specifications for the Content of the Electrical Engineer’s Stamp**

With the Engineers’ Grading Matrix as framework, the team formulated the following specifications for the content of Electrical Engineer’s stamp :

- Full Names of Holder
- Number on the Roll of the Order of Electrical Engineerical
- Code Letters to indicate Specialty – e.g. P, E, T, C
- Grade
- Contact Address
