Terms of Reference

Task Force for the Development of Guidelines for the Evaluation and Grading of Engineers, Technicians, and Installers in the field of Electrotechnology in Cameroon

1. Introduction

The National Order of Electrical Engineers is the official body authorized by law to regulate the practice of Electrotechnology in Cameroon, through the promotion of excellence and enforcement of discipline, so as to ensure public safety, comfort and efficiency for users of electricity.

The Council of the National Order of Electrical Engineers has authorized the Littoral Chapter of the Order to develop a framework document that will serve as guide for the evaluation and grading of Electrical Engineers, Technicians and Installers.

2. Task Force for the Development of Guidelines for the Evaluation and Grading of Engineers, Technicians and Installers in the Field of Electrotechnology

A task force is hereby created to develop guidelines for the evaluation of Engineers, technicians and installers in the field of electrotechnology.

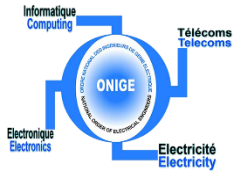
3. Responsibilities of the Task Force

The task force will have the following responsibilities:

- Define a Process for the Evaluation and Grading of Engineers, Technicians and Installers in the Field of Electrotechnology to contain:
 - Criteria for the evaluation and grading persons involved in the field of electrotechnology
 - Weighting of each of the criteria
 - A scale of evaluation (1-5) of Engineers, Technicians and Installers
 - observable indicators for each level of the classification scale
- Establish an Evaluation Form
- Compile a Report on the methodology for classification
- Make recommendation on the levels for which the Engineer's Stamp will be assigned
